#### **Theme**

All floats and vehicles are to be decorated in the 'Out of this world' theme. All entries are subject to approval. Anything deemed inappropriate will be removed from the parade line-up.

#### **Judging**

All entries will be judged during the parade except the floats. There will be a minimum of 3 judges judging every category. Entries will be judged on Best Use of Theme, Originality, and Overall Appearance of the entry.

#### **Awards**

Please see the invitation letter for a description of this year's awards. Posting of the awards will be after the parade at the stage in the Lindsay City Park at approximately 1:30 p.m.

#### **Moving along**

Routines should be no more than 2 minutes. All entries must keep a **forward motion** and keep the same distance from the entry ahead once the parade has begun.
